<p>Clause 5(i) - Life members of the Club shall be those persons who <i>were Life members of Jharkhand State Cricket Association at the time of incorporation of the club</i> and are ready to pay such admission fee and subscription charges as fixed in these articles. Such members will have a right to vote from the time they are enrolled as Life embers of the Club.</p>	<p><i>Any Life member of the Jharkhand State Cricket Association desiring to be enrolled as Life member of the Club and</i> ready to pay such admission fee and subscription charges as fixed in these articles. <p>Clause 5(vii) – Temporary Members being such members who are allowed to use the facilities of the Club as guests of an existing members or as a member of an affiliated club on payment of the requisite charges as may be fixed by the Governing Committee from time to time. Such membership shall be coterminous with the usage of the facilities of the club and shall not be extended in any case beyond such number of days as fixed by the Governing Committee.</p>	<p>Temporary Member being such members who are admitted as member of the club for a period of two years on payment of the requisite Admission fee and other charges as may be fixed by the Governing Committee from time to time.</p>
<p>Clause 5(vii) (a) – <b>To be inserted</b></p>	<p>User Members being such members who are allowed to use the facilities of the Club as guests of an existing member or as a member of an affiliated club on payment of the requisite charges as may be fixed by the Governing Committee from time to time. Such membership shall be coterminous with the usage of the facilities of the club and shall not be extended in any case beyond such number of days as fixed by the Governing Committee.</p>

<p>Clause 7(B)(ii) – Every application for Permanent Membership shall be copied into a candidates’ book to be kept by the Honorary Secretary. The name of the applicant, together with the relevant reference to the Candidates’ Book shall be posted on the Notice Board of the Club for not less than ten days. Members desiring to object to the candidature of a particular person may lodge their objection with the Honorary Secretary within the aforesaid period.</p>	<p>Can be deleted</p>
<p>Clause 8 (v) – A person enrolled as <i>Temporary member shall have to pay an amount of Rs. Two thousand as Entrance Fee</i> in addition to the charges applicable for the use of the facilities of the Club.</p>	<p>A person enrolled as <i>User Member shall have to pay such amount as fixed by the Governing Committee Entrance Fee</i> in addition to the charges applicable for the use of the facilities of the Club.</p>
<p>Clause 15(iii) – If an account is not cleared in full within one (1) month of its becoming due, a reminder shall be given to the member concerned by notifying his name on the Notice Board of the Club. In the event of the member not paying up the dues within a further period of 30 days, a second reminder shall be given in the same manner intimating that if the entire dues are not paid in full within 30 days, <i>the membership shall automatically cease.</i></p>	<p>If an account is not cleared in full within one (1) month of its becoming due, a reminder shall be given to the member concerned by notifying his name on the Notice Board of the Club. In the event of the member not paying up the dues within a further period of 30 days, a second reminder shall be given in the same manner intimating that if the entire dues are not paid in full within <i>the next 30 days, the membership shall become liable to be terminated.</i></p>
<p>Clause 27- At the Ordinary General Meeting held every year the Governing Committee shall lay before the members, Profit and Loss</p>	<p>At the Ordinary General Meeting held every year the Governing Committee shall lay before the members, Profit and Loss Account and a Balance</p>

<p>Account and a Balance Sheet containing a summary of assets and Liabilities of the Club upto the preceding 31<sup>st</sup> day of March. <i>Copies of such accounts, Balance sheet and the Committee's report along with the audited report and the explanatory observations of the committee shall be exhibited on the Notice Board of the Club at least 7 days before the meeting, and a copy thereof shall be sent under certificate of posting at least 21 days before the date of the meeting, to every permanent member at the address registered with the Honorary Secretary.</i></p>	<p>Sheet containing a summary of assets and Liabilities of the Club upto the preceding 31<sup>st</sup> day of March. <i>Copies of such accounts, Balance sheet and the Committee's report along with the audited report and the explanatory notes of the committee, if any, shall be made part of the Annual Report and circulated the Life and Permanent Members of the club at least 21 days before the meeting by posting on the website of the Club as well as by email on their email ID's registered with the Club.</i></p>
<p>Clause 35- The persons subscribing to the memorandum shall constitute the first governing committee of the Club and shall also determine the names of the first set of office bearers of the Club in writing who shall hold office till the first election of the Members of the Governing Committee in the Ordinary General Meeting of the Club.</p>	<p>The persons subscribing to the Memorandum shall constitute the first Governing Committee of the Club and shall also determine the names of the first set of office bearers of the Club in writing who shall hold office till the first election of the Members of the Governing Committee in the Ordinary General Meeting of the Club. <i>Thereafter, the elected members of the Governing Committee, elected every year in the Annual General Meetings shall constitute the Board of Directors of the company/club and the earlier/exiting directors shall cease to be Directors of the company/club.</i></p>
